Introduction

More of us are likely to be killed at work if you work in country Victoria compared with metropolitan Melbourne. Farms also remain the most dangerous workplace in Victoria.

That's why Netball Victoria is very proud to continue its long term partnership with WorkSafe Victoria through the WorkSafe Country Netball League (WCNL). The message of workplace safety is particularly important in regional areas where the prevalence of workplace injury and death is far too high.

Netball Victoria and WorkSafe Victoria would like to thank every League and Club in the Country Netball League for their support of this partnership and assistance with delivery of these important WorkSafe messages.

This document outlines the benefits and obligations attached to this partnership which are provided to and **required of** all Leagues and Clubs participating in the WCNL.

Compliance

All Leagues and Clubs affiliated with the WCNL must agree to comply with and promote WorkSafe Victoria's message of workplace safety.

Leagues and Clubs should liaise with Netball Victoria prior to securing any additional sponsors to ensure they do not conflict with the WorkSafe message.

Leagues and Clubs that do not comply with the sponsorship obligations contained in this Partnership Information Booklet may:

- Receive counselling from Netball Victoria
- Be given a written warning from Netball Victoria
- Lose their WorkSafe sponsorship benefits
- Be removed from the WCNL

WorkSafe Club Safety Fund	Each WCNL club can apply for funding for financial assistance towards improving the safety of the club environment	Clubs must submit an application form detailing the project/initiative for assessment- project funding is at a maximum of \$600/submission (or 50% for less than \$600 submissions) in reimbursement for projects \$1,200 and above in overall cost. One funding allocation per Club is allowed per annum with priority given to those Clubs who have not submitted a successful funding application in the year prior. 



WorkSafe Bib Patches


WorkSafe bib patches must be worn on the front and back of all positional bibs worn during any sanctioned WCNL match. It is preferred that the patches be placed on the top centre of the bib. WorkSafe bib patches must not obscure playing position initials in any way.

Additional bib patches can be ordered through Netball Victoria and will be delivered to the central League address or to individual Clubs.

2nd preference for placement

Please Note: Leagues may have one additional sponsor logo on the playing bibs as per Netball Victoria guidelines provided the WorkSafe logo is in the 1st preference for placement (see above) and that the Leagues sponsor logo is placed in the 2nd preference for placement (see above).

Clubs are NOT permitted to have sponsor logos on playing bibs unless the League opts not to use their bib sponsor location and the League provides them written permission to do so. Please note, written permission can only be granted for one year at a time, written permission must be gained by the Club from their appropriate League. Clubs may display sponsor logos on uniform items such as dresses/tops, tracksuits and bags.

NOTE: Screen printing of WorkSafe logo onto bibs is possible provided that minimum size and positioning requirements are adhered to. That is:

- The WorkSafe logo must be at least 7.4 cm long and 3.5 cm high and must appear on a white background at least 7.8 cm high x 4.0 cm long.
- Leagues / Clubs must obtain Netball Victoria approval of artwork prior to screen printing going ahead.

WORKSAFE CLUB SAFETY FUND

Introduction

WorkSafe Victoria, in partnership with Netball Victoria, are working together to raise the profile of workplace safety in regional and rural Victoria. Research indicates that if you live in country Victoria, you are more likely to be killed at work than those working in metropolitan Melbourne. Farms remain Victoria's most dangerous workplace.

To promote netball as a safe and healthy sport for players, coaches, umpires, volunteers, officials and spectators, the WorkSafe Club Safety Fund has been established to provide financial assistance to football/netball Clubs to improve the safety of the Club environment.

Objective

The objective of the WorkSafe Club Safety Fund is to provide financial support at a local level to assist with occupational health and safety initiatives to improve safety.

Who can apply?

Netball/Football Clubs that are members of the WorkSafe Country Netball League.

How much are the grants?

- WorkSafe provides an annual funding pool for the WorkSafe Club Safety Fund to be dispersed at the discretion of Netball Victoria upon successful approval of WorkSafe Club Safety Fund applications
- The WorkSafe Club Safety Fund will provide grants to the value of 50% of the total project cost at a maximum grant reimbursement of \$600 / application.
- Only 1x WorkSafe Club Safety Fund grant will be provided per Club per annum.
- Priority will be given to Club's that have not received funding in the previous year's round of grants.

Funding Categories

Funding is available for safety initiatives including, but not limited to:

- Equipment to be purchased by the Club that has the purpose of protecting individual participants while actively engaged in the sport (e.g. first aid kits, drink containers etc.)
- Permanent or portable structures that provide shelter (e.g. shelter shed, shade sails).
- First-aid courses.
- Minor facility maintenance which presents an occupational health and safety hazard.

Clubs successful in receiving funding are required to:

- Use the funds for the specified activity.
- Send a receipt to Netball Victoria.
- Advise Netball Victoria if the project has been cancelled and return all monies paid within 14 days.
- Be responsible for ensuring adequate insurance cover for any equipment purchased.
- Complete any evaluation required by WorkSafe and/or Netball Victoria.



Essential Funding Criteria

- Applications must be made on the official application form. All areas of the form must be completed
 including attaching copies of all relevant documentation such as quotes.
- Photographic evidence of use of WorkSafe signage, equipment and clothing at your club venue must be supplied with completed application form.
- If the club does not have an ABN, a Statement of Supplier Form must be submitted with the application form.
- Netball Victoria staff may be contacted for advice when preparing project outline.

Please note: Retrospective funding will not be approved under any circumstances.

Expected Timeline

- Applications will be assessed as soon as all relevant information has been provided.
- Notification of funding will be forwarded within four weeks of receipt of the application. Approved
 applications will receive further information regarding funding requirements.
- On approval of funding, the total amount will be credited directly into the club account.
- The first round of funding commences on Monday 17th February 2014 and concludes on Friday 2 May 2014

Goods and Services Tax (GST)

Funding grants are subject to GST and clubs must abide by one of the three options outlined below:

- 1. Club has an ABN and is registered for the GST
 - The club will need to supply Netball Victoria with a tax invoice (receipt) for the approved funding amount including GST within 28 days of receipt of the grant.
- 2. Club has an ABN but is not registered for the GST
 - The club will need to supply Netball Victoria with a receipt for the approved funding amount (no GST) within 28 days of receipt of the grant
- 3. Club does not have an ABN
 - The club must complete a 'Statement by Supplier Reason for not quoting an Australian Business Number (ABN) to an enterprise' form and submit with the application form.
