Guiding Principles



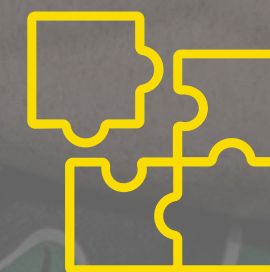
Inclusive

- Maximise opportunities within AFL Victoria's Community Club Sustainability Program to further enhance football competitions.
- Use relationships with the Bendigo Pioneers and Bendigo Strikers to attract the best young talent in the region.
- Leverage our commitment to Interleague to recruit and retain the best talent possible.

- Anticipate future growth and assist Clubs with their facility Master Planning.
- Liaise with local stakeholders to ensure our Finals home, the QEO, is continually evolved and maxmised to it's greatest capacity.

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Focus Areas

Operational Excellence

- Annually review and evaluate progress against this strategic plan with any updates to be communicated to all Clubs and key stakeholders.
- Recruit and retain people on a skills basis to a high level of professionalism and leadership.
- Implement a succession plan for the BFNL Board to ensure sustainability.
- Ensure our Board and Staff are role models for the values of the BFNL.

Financial Stability

- Maintain sound and transparent financial practices including thorough budgeting and accurate financial reporting.
- Increase BFNL financial sustainability through the maximisation of revenue and partnership opportunities.

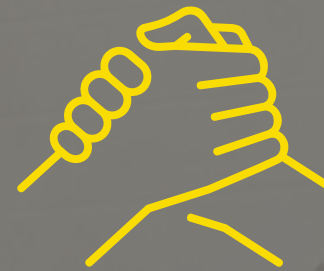
