To be considered eligible to be crowned the eventual winner of the Rising Star award for both football and netball, each player must meet the following criteria:

- Players must be under 19 years of age at the commencement of the 2026 season.
- They must have played no more than 10 Senior Football or A-Grade Netball games prior to the commencement of the 2026 season.
- All clubs can each nominate a maximum of 2 x football and 2 x netball future stars each
- A league appointed selection panel will then determine the eventual winner, who will be presented with the award on Michelsen & Thompson Medal day.

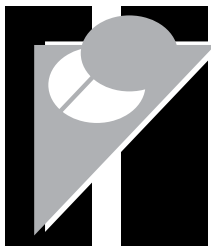
## **Rosa re-appointed to lead Senior Squad**

The win reinforced the strength of the BFNL competition and continued the momentum built under Rosa's leadership, with the league now turning its attention to another exciting representative campaign in 2027.

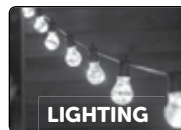

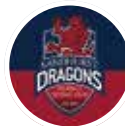

## Showdowns between four teams in the top five on the senior footy ladder highlight round 15 in the Bendigo Bank Bendigo FNL season.

A resurgent Eaglehawk will be back on its turf at C and M Oval in Canterbury Park to tackle Gisborne as Sandhurst and South Bendigo renew their rivalry at Queen Elizabeth Oval.

The Hawks are riding a four-match winning streak which includes wins against South Bendigo and Strathfieldsaye by 48 and 68 points the past two rounds.

Fifth in the premiership race on an 8-5 record, Eaglehawk's confidence is soaring in its pursuit of back-to-back premierships.

A Borough line-up coached by Travis Matheson, non-playing, and Clayton Holmes, playing, will be fired up for a big match on home turf.

It will be Gisborne's final trip to the Borough.

Just seven points separated the Bulldogs and Hawks at Gisborne's Gardiner Reserve in round six.

The Rob Waters-coached Gisborne fought on for a 102-95 victory.

An Eaglehawk attack that includes Bailey Ilsley, Jacquin Mifsud, Jack O'Shannessy, Nick Thompson, and possibly Clayton Holmes will be a huge test for Gisborne's defence.

The Bulldogs' back six is led superbly by captain Zach Vescovi.

This match will feature three Michelsen medallists in Eaglehawk guns Billy Evans and Noah Wheeler, and Gisborne ruck-rover Brad Bernacki.

Gisborne's squad includes ruckman Braidon Blake who tied with Bernacki and Sandhurst's Lachlan Tardrew for the medal two seasons ago.

Blake has not played since round seven.

Key players for Gisborne include Shane Clough, Zac Denahy, James Gray and Thomas Werner.

Gun forward Pat McKenna did not play in last Saturday's four goal win against Castlemaine.

It's first against fourth as Sandhurst and South Bendigo clash at the QEO.

Both clubs were long-time co-tenants at the city's premier oval.

In round six it was South Bendigo which reclaimed the Graeme Wright Memorial Cup in a 98-50 victory against the Dragons at Harry Trott Oval.

The Bloods bounced back from an eight-goal defeat at Eaglehawk in the 13th round to dominate last Saturday's showdown with Broadford.

A 10-goal haul by Brock Harvey put South Bendigo's ace forward well in contention for consecutive Ron Best Medal wins as the competition's leading goalkicker.

Players to watch in the red and white include Callum Crisp, Coen Harker, Brody Haddow and Isaiah Miller.

The Bloods are coached by Troy Coates, non-playing, and Jack Fallon, playing.

The depth in a Dragons' squad coached by Bryce Curnow, non-playing, and Fergus Greene, playing, has faced a big test across the season.

Key players for Sandhurst include Hugh Schmetzer, Connor Sexton, Cooper Smith, Nick Stagg and Dayten Uerata.

Golden Square will aim to continue its long-running winning streak against Kangaroo Flat when the Bulldogs and Roos clash at Gourmet Pantry Oval in Wade Street.

The Bulldogs had the bye last round as Kangaroo Flat faced Sandhurst.

In round six, Golden Square won by 39 points on the Roos' ground.

Key players in the Bulldogs' line-up include Harry Burke, Jack McMahon, Jordan Rosengren, Jack Stewart, Bailey and Noah Warfe.

A Golden Square team coached by Brad Eaton, non-playing, and Liam Barrett, playing, will be determined not to allow the Roos to take the points.

Kangaroo Flat played well to be within 19-points

of Sandhurst going into the second half of last Saturday's clash.

The Tyrone Downie-coached Kangaroos will be desperate not to allow the Bulldogs to get a run of four consecutive goals or more.

Players to watch for the Roos include ruckman Angus Macpherson, Aaron Nevins, captain Ethan Roberts, Nick Lang, Tyran Farmer and Sam Barnes.

A tough run for Broadford keeps rolling.

The Nathan Thompson-coached Kangaroos will be on their turf at Harley Hammond Reserve to face a Strathfieldsaye line-up on the rebound from defeat.

Broadford's best in last Saturday's clash with South Bendigo were Louis Thompson, Owen Sloan, captain Adam Miles, and Harry Behan.

The Kangaroos will face a huge challenge against Storm's slick teamwork from stoppages, and also limiting the play of Strathfieldsaye's forwards.

The charge by the Jeff Andrews-coached Storm in a 10-2 run is being led by Daniel Clohesy, Jaidi Jackson-Leahy, Lachlan Ratcliffe, James Schischka and many more.

Castlemaine has the bye.

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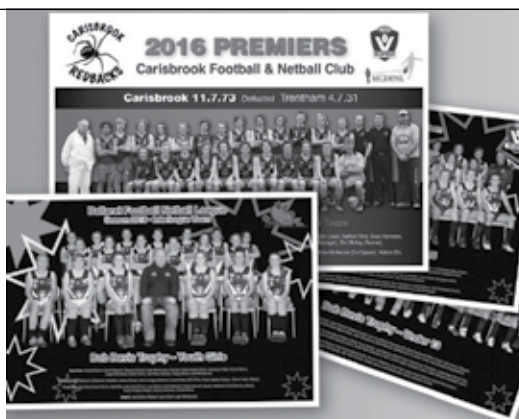


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# RISING STAR AWARD 2026

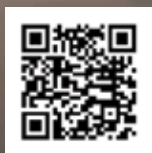

## Roos win city's 1955 minor league flag

**Following some very lean and frustrating years after World War 2 Kangaroo Flat burst out of the pack and won the 1955 Golden City Football League flag.**

And in that season they went down in only one game, posting 19 wins in one of the finest seasons in the Roos' long history which dates back to 1862.

Ron Lee had returned to Dower Park as senior coach and under his rigorous training programme the Roos turned out fitter than they had in many seasons.

So there was a real buzz around the club as the side ran out to take on the Harry Morgan-coached North Bendigo, but after holding a 14-point half-time lead the North side overran the Roos.

No one knew it at the time but that would be Flat's only loss for 1955.

And roll on the Roos did. Rex Kelsey booted six goals in the Flat's win over YCW, they downed Harcourt and Northern United and with Ken Nankivell transferring across from Sandhurst they trounced White Hills by 100 points.

And so the return match with North loomed. In front of the largest home-and-away crowd on record for the Association, but just five goals were scored on the day.

The inaccurate Roos bombarded their home goals but managed just three goals from 21 scoring shots.

Final scores: Kangaroo Flat 3.18 (36) def. North Bendigo 2.3 (15).

Victory over Harcourt was marred by the news the Apple Eaters were lodging a protest against the Flat-appointed goal umpire for allegedly handing down three incorrect decisions.

And as the Roos had won by only seven points Harcourt officials were convinced had the decisions been reversed they would have won.

Strangely enough the matter went no further than the Saturday night protest with the decisions --- or lack of decisions ---- dismissed and the Roos remaining on top of the ladder.

With Tom Bowery and George Edwards both celebrating their 100-game milestones against White Hills the Roos made sure the milestones would be well remembered.

The Hillies were thrashed by 121 points and in the Twos where Edwards was skipper Kangaroo Flat won by 16 points.

But it was a bumper season in 1955 when Kangaroo Flat ended up on 19 wins and one loss to win the flag very comfortably.

Early in the season the Roos downed reigning premiers YCW with Bob Wilson nailing six majors and Kelsey on top in defence.

The wins rolled on as Harcourt and Northern United were dispatched and even though the Roos were down to 17 men for the entire second half against the Apple Eaters they beat them by 15 points.

Injuries to Gren Tonzing and Max Owen in the Harcourt game sidelined them for quite a few weeks but the Roos rolled on with recruit Ken Nankivell from Sandhurst fitting in well.

White Hills was thrashed by 100+ points and all eyes were on the North Bendigo return clash. That wasn't a problem so by the end of the home-and-away rounds the Roos were on top after a 17-match winning streak with the fans and players focussed on second semi-final day.

Fans of North Bendigo and the Roos packed into the Kennington ground with the occasion a big one for North. It was their first finals appearance since joining the Association in 1946 (straight after WW2) while for the Roos it was their first grand final appearance since 1948.

The Flat made it a special day for Stan Wild, playing his 150th game for the Roos. They kept North at bay all afternoon and won the semi-final 11.11 (77) to 7.13 (55).

Grand final day arrived and the pace of Kangaroo Flat and their aerial supremacy won the day, marking a reward for coach Ron Lee, and he was in fine form at the celebratory dinner in the Golden Square Fire Station.

\*More to come in future Flat articles, but their form didn't quite measure up to that shown in 1955. They ended up fifth in 1956, semi-finalists in

1957, preliminary finalists in 1958 and 1959 before once again taking home the flag in 1960.

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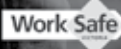
