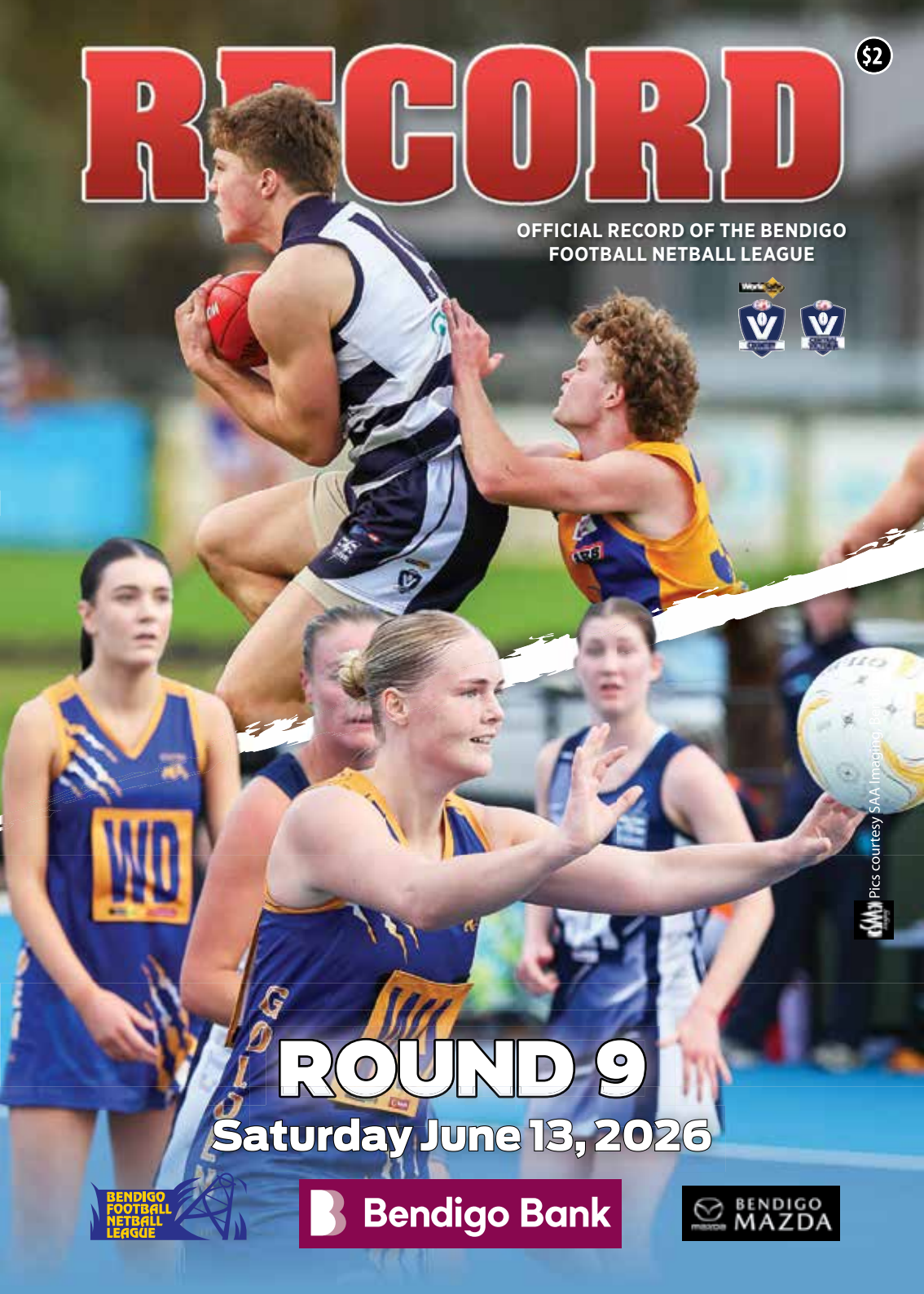

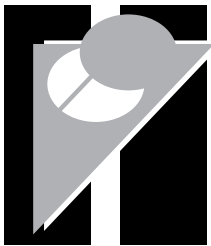

# Round Preview



## **Castlemaine is still chasing a big scalp rolling into the ninth round of the Bendigo Bank Bendigo FNL's senior footy action.**

The Bailey Henderson-coached Castlemaine Magpies will eye a strong chance to prove their top-five credentials by beating Sandhurst at Queen Elizabeth Oval.

A 207-point win at home against Broadford last round meant Castlemaine soared to the fifth rung on the ladder.

The Magpies' wins have been against Golden Square, Kangaroo Flat and Broadford.

Castlemaine has battled to match higher-placed opponents across four quarters.

Players to watch for the Magpies include Michael Hartley who kicked 15 goals against Broadford to now be equal second in the race for the Ron Best Medal for leading goalkicker on 26.

Castlemaine's best against Broadford included Hunter Staples, Harrison Sheahan, Jack Chester and captain Darby Semmens.

Taking on Sandhurst in the Dragons' den is another stern test for the Magpies.

Pressure from Sandhurst which has been runner-up, premier and runner-up across the past three seasons will be much higher than what Castlemaine faced last round.

As the Magpies dominated play at Broadford the Sandhurst line-up showed it's still a force to be reckoned with.

Stung by consecutive defeats the previous two rounds, Sandhurst struck back to score an 11-point win at Gisborne's Gardiner Reserve.

The Bryce Curnow and Fergus Greene-coached Dragons faced a 25-point deficit at half-time, but then seized control in the final hour.

As Sandhurst scored nine goals in the second half it kept Gisborne to just two majors.

By the final siren the Dragons were up 86-75.

Key players in Sandhurst's fighting victory were Lachie Hood, Lachlan Wright, Cooper Smith and Jack Keating.

A talented squad in maroon and blue includes James Coghlan, Caleb Connick, Cobi Maxted and Hugh Schmetzer.

It's the clash of two breed of Bulldog as Golden Square faces Gisborne at Gourmet Pantry Oval.

Both teams are on the rebound from defeat.

Massive test for Golden Square on-ballers Daniel Keating, Jordan Rosengren, Jack McMahon and Liam Barrett against Boyd Nalder, Brad Bernacki, Adam Brancatisano and James Gray.

In defence, Golden Square will look to Jayden and Harry Burke, and Noah Warfe to curb the impact Gisborne forwards Zac Denahy and Pat McKenna have on the match.

Broadford's back on home turf at Harley Hammond Reserve to take on Eaglehawk.

The Nathan Thompson-coached Broadford faces the reigning premier desperate for a percentage-lifting win and chance to regain its place in the top five.

Huge test awaits a Broadford defence that includes Adam Miles, Jarrah Younger, Riley Edwards and Ben Thompson.

No matter the level being played the defence relies greatly on pressure from team-mates further afield.

Eaglehawk had the bye last round after a 22-point win at home against Castlemaine in round seven.

Key players for the Travis Matheson and Clayton Holmes-coached Eaglehawk include ruckman Callum Heath, Billy Evans, Jonty Neaves, and talented forwards Bailey Ilsley and Jack O'Shannessy.

Kangaroo Flat is back on its ground at Bendigo Mazda Oval in Dower Park to take on Strathfieldsaye Storm.

Although it was beaten by 32 points, Kangaroo Flat will have gained plenty of confidence from its clash on South Bendigo's turf at Harry Trott Oval.

The Tyrone Downie-coached Kangaroos were able to score consecutive goals several times.

A highlight was the final term when the Roos

bounced from a 42-point deficit at the start of the quarter to be within 23 points after a hat-trick of goals.

From there it was the more experienced South Bendigo which kicked away for a 113-81 victory.

Kangaroo Flat's attack was led by great clubman Nick Lang on three goals as Sam Barnes and Nick Keogh kicked two each.

Players to watch for the Roos include ruckman Angus Macpherson, Aaron Nevins, Jaye Hywood, Jordan Rouse and Zach Bird.

On a five-match winning streak, Strathfieldsaye has grabbed second place on the ladder.

The Jeff Andrews-coached Storm won every quarter in the King's Birthday holiday weekend clash with Golden Square at Triple M Park to win by 39 points.

Best for Strathfieldsaye were Ben Lester, Pat Blake, Cooper Jones and Riley Mulquiny.

A talented squad representing Storm includes Zach Charles and James Schischka in defence, Tyson McKenzie, Lachlan Ratcliffe and ruckman George Simpson.

South Bendigo has the bye.

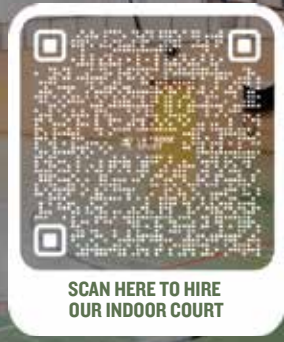

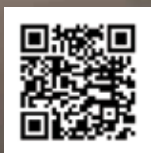

## Hawks cling onto fifth spot, mid-season 2006

**Eaglehawk moved back into fifth spot on the BFNL senior ladder with a big 73-point win over Kyneton in Rd. 8, 2006.**

After a hard-fought first half with just four goals separating the teams, the Two Blues dominated the second half nailing 11 goals to the Tigers' four. Kyneton was still in the game at the long break --- but only just --- trailing 6.9 to 10.10, as the Eaglehawk defence stifled the Tiger forwards, apart from Steven 'Revenue' Reaper, in the second half.

Reaper nailed six of the Tigers' 10 goals with no other Kyneton forward worthy of a mention.

For several seasons Filo and Reaper were teammates at Kyneton before 'Revenue' joined Gisborne, but it was another occasion (of many in that era) when the Hawks' coach had tried to plot ways to stop the champion full-forward.

"He's a class act so Kyneton look to kick to him a lot. And the reality is he will kick majors no matter what you try to do.

"Overall our defence and midfield worked hard to not allow too many easy passes to Reaps," said Filo.

The Hawks had promoted Travis St. Clair to No. 1 ruckman, replacing Nick Heath who was playing against his old club.

In his comeback to the BFNL St. Clair went into the Kyneton game with 35 goals to lead the Reserves goalkicking and in the seniors match against the Tigers, like 'Roggo', he nailed four majors.

"He gave us a big target to kick to in attack and played really well," Filo added.

And acting skipper Brad Rogerson marked his second match back from injury by nailing four goals. A knee injury had sidelined 'Roggo' for most of the 2006 season and then on his return he added plenty of skill to the Eaglehawk attack.

"It will be another two to three weeks before "Roggo" can play back in the midfield, but he is doing really well up forward," Filo said.

After the long break Eaglehawk sailed away booting 11 snag rolls to four and managed to hold onto fifth place on the BFNL ladder but only by percentage over Castlemaine.

The Maine lost its round 8 match to South Bendigo in a high-scoring match where 33 goals were kicked --- the Bloods had nine goalkickers and the Camp Reserve Pies had eight.

The Bloods led by a solitary point at half-time --- 6.9 to 6.8 --- but an eight-major third term burst sealed the Pies' fate with Danny 'Breezer' O'Bree leading South's big goal-kicking list with five.

He drilled four of those five in the desperate final term with his ability to outmark opponents in one-on-one duels a key highlight.

Coach Ian Martin tried four, different Castlemaine opponents on O'Bree -- Adam Culvenor, Chris Jardine, Aiden Millard and Alan McLennan --- but none could shut him down in the Bloods' full-forward line.

O'Bree was quick at full-time to water down his performance.

"Playing out of the goal square is something we've tried a few times this year, but it hadn't come off," he said.

"I suppose if you do it time and time again it will have to pay off at some stage, but I wouldn't be getting too carried away with it."

And despite O'Bree's later final term onslaught, the young Magpies had closed the margin to just 10 points only 12 minutes into the final term.

David Taylor nailed the third of his three for the day, followed up by Lachie Brown and the talented Brock Bouch.

But the Bloods' simple game plan then kicked in as South Bendigo players realised kicking long to O'Bree was the answer and he sank three of the match's final four goals to give South a commanding 37-point win.

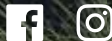
